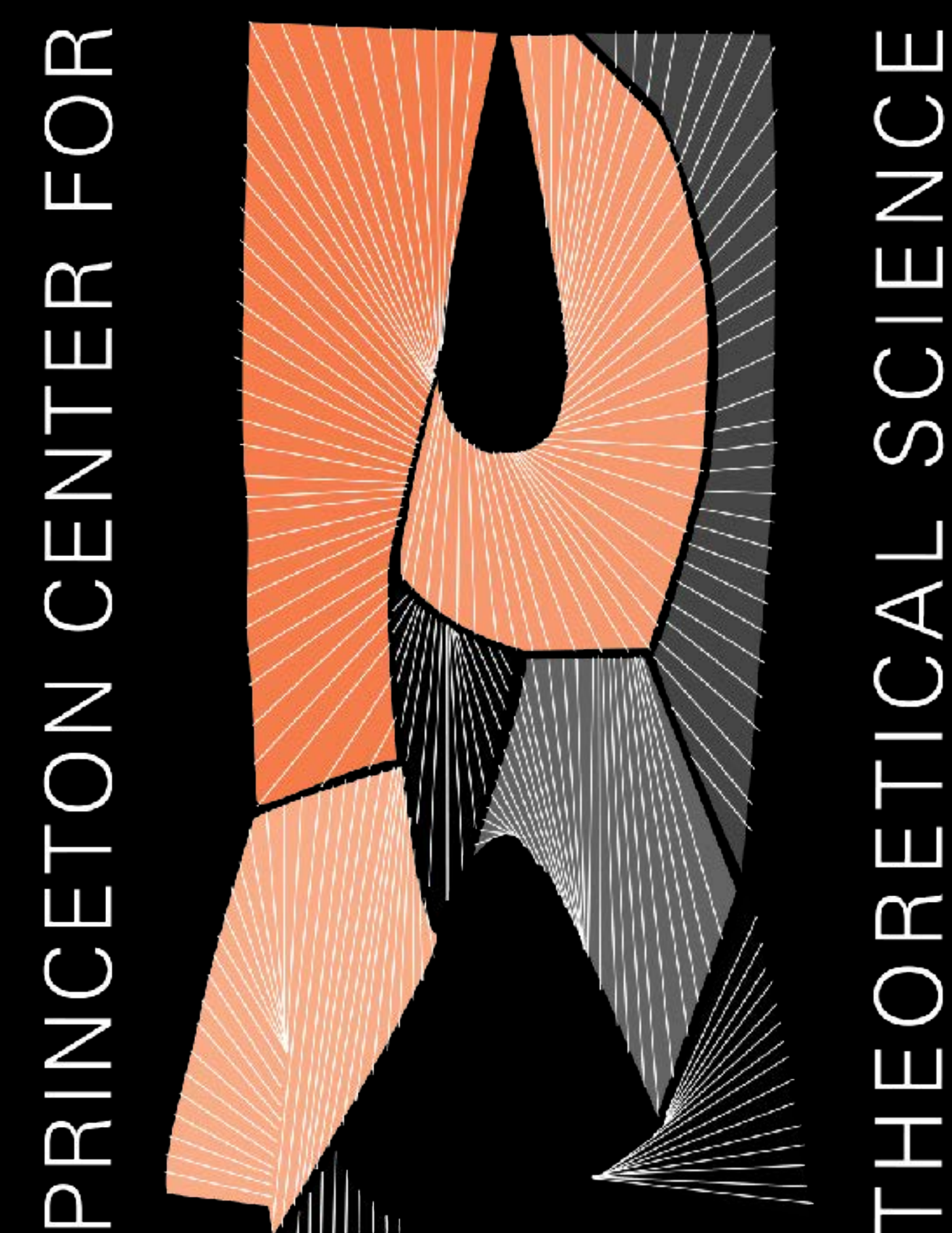


Space: The Final Frontier of Microbial Communities
